Keith Pollnow, President and Chief Executive Officer of Choice Bank, announced the proposed formation of a new bank holding company called Choice Bancorp, Inc. If approved by shareholders and regulators, the reorganization will result in Choice Bank becoming a wholly owned subsidiary of Choice Bancorp, Inc. and current shareholders of Choice Bank will receive one share of Choice Bancorp, Inc. common stock for each share of Choice Bank common stock they currently own.

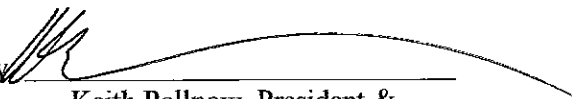
The shareholders of Choice Bank will be asked to approve the reorganization transaction at a special meeting that will be held later this year. The parties expect to make initial filings for regulatory approvals, as well as file a registration statement with the SEC, by late March.
